THE SOUTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (SJTA) BUS PERMIT FEE INCREASES FROM \$2.00 TO \$2.80 ON **MARCH 1, 2007**

In accordance with the South Jersey Transportation Authority Rules and Regulations, the bus permit entry fee will increase from \$2.00 to \$2.80, **effective March 1, 2007**. The bus permit fee is required for each and every motorbus entering Atlantic City. The increase is permitted under Section 22 of the South Jersey Transportation Authority Act (N.J.S.A. 27:25A-22b).

Therefore by **March 1, 2007**, new permits must be either purchased or old pink permits in your inventory exchanged for new ones along with the eighty-cents difference in cost. For example, if you have 10 pink permits in your inventory that you want to exchange you must send a check in for \$8.00 plus the shipping and handling fee of \$3.00, totaling \$11.00. The Authority's exchange period will run from **February 14, 2007 to July 31, 2007**. Permits will be exchanged by mail only, no walk ins or cash will be accepted. Also note, new permits will be available for sale February 14, 2007.

All permits must be purchased **in advance** no less than two weeks prior to the scheduled bus arrival date by check or money order payable to South Jersey Transportation Authority, 25 South New York Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ 08401. Attached is a new permit order form for your convenience and use.

Additionally to ensure a smooth transition, the Authority would appreciate your assistance in notifying all motorcoach drivers of this permit fee increase as well.

The annual bus medallions and annual fleet medallions are not affected by this change at this time.
